It appears from a perusal of the prayers in the writ petition that there are two distinct prayers, one seeking transfer of the rectification proceedings from the authority concerned and the other seeking cancellation of the registration of the trade mark.

2. A query was raised before the learned counsel for the petitioner as to how two distinct reliefs, involving separate adjudicatory proceedings, could be sought in a single writ petition. The prayer seeking transfer of the proceedings may also attract the applicability of Rule 14 and other relevant provisions, which require consideration.

3. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to obtain instructions as to whether the writ petition is to be withdrawn or whether any of the prayers are to be given up.

4. In the meantime, the Registry is directed to place a note before this Court as to the maintainability of a writ petition containing the aforesaid dual prayers, so as to assist the Court in considering the issue.
