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ORDER

The present writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 28.10.2021 and 24.11.2021.

2.Mere a direction for consideration without there being any legal basis should be avoided. In the case on hand, while perusing the factual position, the petitioner has already filed a writ petition in W.P No.7877 of 2021 for regularisation of his service, based upon his representation dated 27.06.2018. In pursuance thereof, this Court vide order dated 26.03.2021 directed the respondent authority to consider his representation. Based on which, the Deputy Commissioner conducted a personal hearing with the petitioner on 23.04.2021 and finally, has rejected his request for regularisation vide a communication dated 06.05.2021.

3.At this juncture, it appears that the petitioner again sent the representations dated 28.10.2021 and 24.11.2021 so as to enable him to rejoin duty. Admittedly, from the very submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court could not find any material as to the challenging of the



above rejection order dated 06.05.2021. Therefore, having suffered a rejection order, mere sending another representation will not give any fresh cause of action for the petitioner to again direct the respondent authority to consider an issue which has already been reached finality. Thus, this Court absolutely does not find any merits in this writ petition.

4. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed. No costs. However, the dismissal of this writ petition shall not debar the petitioner from claiming her monetary benefits, if any, in accordance with her eligibility and on merits. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
