ORDER

(Order of the Court was delivered by **P.VELMURUGAN, J.**)

The respondent herein/plaintiff instituted a suit in C.O.S.No.738 of 2022 on the file of the Additional Commercial Court, Egmore, Chennai, seeking recovery of a sum of Rs.21,57,777.87/-, together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum. By judgment dated 06.11.2025, the Court below has partly decreed the suit and directed the first defendant/first petitioner to pay a sum of Rs.16,22,476/- to the plaintiff/respondent, along with subsequent interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of plaint till the date of realization with proportionate costs. Aggrieved by the said judgment and decree, the present appeal has been preferred by the petitioners/defendants.



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2. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances and also considering the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, there shall be an order of interim stay on condition that the first petitioner/first defendant is directed to deposit the decretal amount of Rs.16,22,476/- (Rupees Sixteen Lakhs Twenty Two Thousand Four Hundred and Seventy Six only) on or before 10.04.2026 to the credit of the suit in C.O.S.No.738 of 2022 in the Indian Bank, High Court Branch, Chennai, in an interest-bearing Fixed Deposit Account and the same shall be renewed periodically. In default of such deposit within the time stipulated, the interim stay granted by this Court shall stand automatically vacated.

4. List the matter on 15.04.2026.
