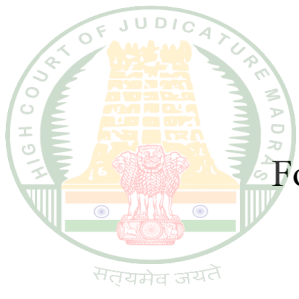

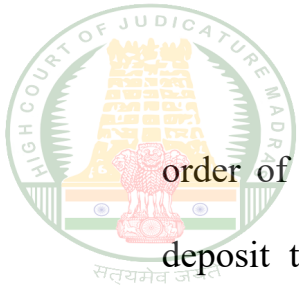
J U D G M E N T

(Judgment of the Court was made by P.Velmurugan, J.)

The respondents herein/plaintiffs instituted a suit in C.O.S.No.52 of 2025 on the file of the Principal Commercial Court, Egmore, Chennai, seeking a direction to the appellant herein/defendant to pay a sum of Rs.60,00,000/-, together with future interest at the rate of 12% per annum, to the second respondent/second plaintiff. By judgment and decree dated 11.12.2025, the Court below allowed the suit and directed the appellant/defendant to pay the second plaintiff a sum of Rs.60,00,000/- with subsequent interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date of plaint till the date of realisation with proportionate costs. Aggrieved by the said judgment and decree, the present appeal has been preferred by the appellant/defendant.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the appellant and perused the materials available on record.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances and also considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the appellant, there shall be an



order of interim stay on condition that the appellant/defendant is directed to deposit the decretal amount of Rs.60,00,000/- (Rupees Sixty Lakhs) on or before 30.04.2026 to the credit of Appeal (CAD) No.36 of 2026 in the Indian Bank, High Court Branch, Chennai, in an interest-bearing Fixed Deposit Account and the same shall be renewed periodically. In default of such deposit within the time stipulated, the interim stay granted by this Court shall stand automatically vacated.

4. Issue notice to respondents returnable by 30.04.2026. Private notice is also permitted. Affidavit of Service has to be filed by then, failing which, the appeal shall stand dismissed automatically, without further reference to this Court.

5. List the matter on 30.04.2026.
