3. Post on 15.07.2026, immediately after admissions.

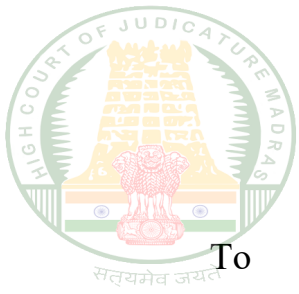
