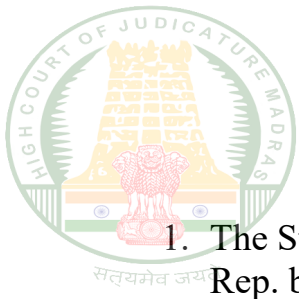

Prayer in WP/6608//2024: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records of the 4th Respondent in proceedings having Ref. No. P16/11631001/1/ PPO. No.R2411587, dated 12.10.2023 and quash the same as illegal in so far as the monthly basic pension of the Petitioner has been reduced by the 4th Respondent from Rs.25,255/- to Rs.19,861/- by the proceedings dated 12.10.2023 and consequently direct the 4th Respondent to continue to pay the basic pension of Rs.25,255/- per month to the petitioner.

Prayer in WP/4727/2024: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records of the 4th Respondent in proceedings having Ref. No AG (A & E) PEN P23 / 12329360/4/R2412974/688 Dated 06.02.2024 and quash the same as illegal in so far as the monthly basic pension of the petitioner has been reduced



by the 4th Respondent from Rs.26,125 to Rs.20,545 by the proceedings dated 06.02.2024 and consequently direct the 4th Respondent to continue to pay the basic pension of Rs.26,125 per month to the petitioner.
