COMMON ORDER

Mr.Umashankar, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the revision petitioner is originally a share holder of judgment debtor Company and today he is the Director of the said Company. There were parallel proceedings initiated

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against the said Company which went up to the Hon'ble Supreme Court and because of infighting amongst the share holders and the Director there was some communication gap which resulted in an exparte decree being passed.

2. The learned counsel however states that the petitioner is now willing to settle the claim of the respondent/decreed holder and to show bonafide, today a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs only) by way of cheque, subject to clearance is handed over to the learned counsel for the respondent and the same is received by the learned counsel for the respondent without prejudice to the contention in the civil revision petition. The learned counsel for the petitioner also states that a further sum of Rs.18 lakhs would be released within a period of two weeks from today and the entire balance amount would be settled within a period of six weeks thereafter.

3. Post the matter on 27.08.2026 for compliance of the second instalment.

4. Interim order already granted by this Court is extended till then.

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
