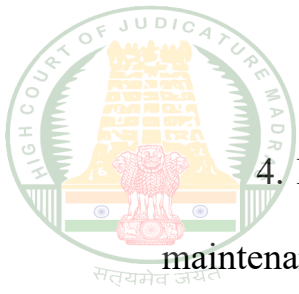
ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by C.V.Karthikeyan J.)

Admit.

2. This appeal had been preferred by the petitioner in O.P.No.414 of 2020 on the file of Principal Family Court, Chennai aggrieved by the dismissal of petition seeking dissolution of marriage on the ground of cruelty and desertion by order dated 12.12.2025.

3. The learned counsel for the respondent is present.



4. It had been contended that in C.R.P (PD) Nos.4281 and 4283 of 2024 maintenance of Rs.40,000/- had been determined till the disposal of O.P.No.414 of 2020. It had been contended by the respondent that after disposal, the appellant is not paying the said amount. It is axiomatic that an appeal is continuation of the original proceedings and any order passed regarding maintenance during the pendency of the original petition should also be continued during the pendency of the appeal.

5. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that no application had been filed by the respondent.

6. The order in Civil Revision Petitions had attained finality. The appellant is bound to pay the same. Hence, we would direct the appellant to continue to pay Rs.40,000/- [Rupees Forty Thosand Only] towards maintenance from 12.12.2025 till the disposal of the present appeal.
