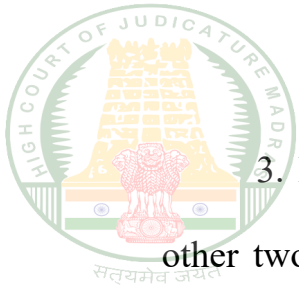

ORDER

The learned counsel for the revision petitioners submitted that DVAC proceedings were initiated by the defendants/complainants based on false allegations. He also stated that the marriage between the de facto complainant and the first petitioner took place in the year 2006, and they have two sons and one daughter, with the eldest son being 18 years old.

2. It is contended that the complainant has now initiated proceedings alleging harassment by the husband, based on certain past incidents. The learned counsel submitted that due to misunderstandings, the complainant has filed the petition, after decades and even the elder daughter is now married. Therefore, it is prayed that the proceedings be struck off.

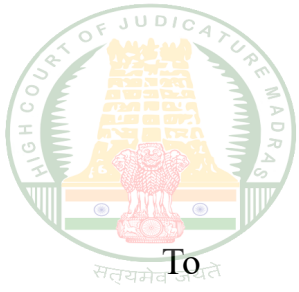


3. Issue notice to the first respondent, returnable by 23.06.2026. As the other two respondents are minor sons, their personal appearance is dispensed with.
