ORDER

This civil revision petition is filed to direct the learned Additional District Judge, at Dharmapuri to dispose of the Appeal Suit in As No. 7 of 2017 within the stipulated time fixed by this Court.

2. As the prayer in this revision petition is only to direct the Appellate Court to dispose of the appeal as expeditiously as possible, notice to the respondents is dispensed with.

3. When the matter was taken up for admission, this Court directed the learned Additional District Judge, Dharmapuri, to submit a report on the delay in disposing the appeal in AS.No.7/2017, which supposedly is at the notice stage from 2017 onwards. Pursuant thereto, the learned Additional District Judge, Dharmapuri, submitted a Report on 08.04.2026, stating that due to pendency of various Interlocutory Applications, like application to bring on record the legal heirs of the deceased 7th Respondent, application under 01 Rule 10 CPC and application for temporary injunction, the appeal could not be taken up for final disposal. The learned Judge further stated that as soon as the interlocutory applications are disposed of, he would propel the appeal to the



arguments stage for early disposal.

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4. This Court accepts the explanation offered by the learned Judge for the delay in disposing the appeal and therefore this Court is not inclined to fix a specific time for the disposal of the appeal. In any event, this Court would only urge the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Dharmapuri to dispose the appeal as expeditiously as possible.

5. With the above direction, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. No costs.
