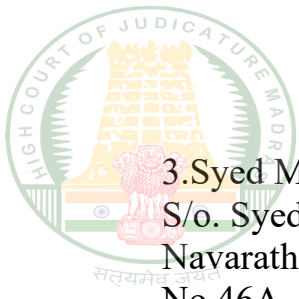

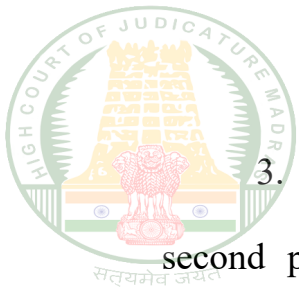

ORDER

Aggrieved by the proceedings initiated under the DV Act by the de facto complainant (first respondent), the in-laws have preferred this revision before this Court.

2. Before the trial Court, the in-laws/revision petitioners admittedly remained ex parte. The husband (third respondent in this revision and first respondent in the original petition) is employed in Dubai, while the other respondents are his relatives residing in India. Due to lack of communication, they were unable to appear before the trial Court.



3. The first petitioner is the mother-in-law, aged about 74 years. The second petitioner is the sister-in-law, aged about 54 years, and the third petitioner is her husband, aged about 63 years. The first petitioner is residing at Trichy, while the others are residing at Chennai. The de facto complainant (first respondent) is residing at Kancheepuram along with her minor daughter, aged about 16 years.

4. The third respondent is presently in Dubai and appeared before this Court through video conference. He submitted that, due to work conditions, he does not have a permanent job. The fourth respondent, Jacqueline, is stated to be his second wife.

5. It appears that the dispute is matrimonial in nature between the parties, and the de facto complainant is living separately with her minor daughter. It is also noted that the first petitioner is a senior citizen aged about 74 years, and the other petitioners are in-laws. The third respondent further submitted that he is not on talking terms with his parents due to the dispute with the first respondent.

6. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that the third respondent is bound to maintain his daughter. Accordingly, the third respondent is directed to pay a sum of Rs. 15,000/- as interim maintenance to Respondents 1 and 2 until further modification.

7. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable by 30.04.2026. In the meantime, further proceedings in DVC No.6 of 2025, on the file of the Judicial



Magistrate, Sripermbudur, Kanchipuram, are stayed till then.

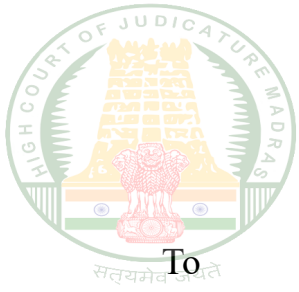
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8. The third respondent is directed to pay Rs. 15,000/- as interim maintenance to Respondents 1 and 2 on or before 30.04.2026, either through counsel or by depositing the amount into their bank account. In case of default, this order shall stand vacated.

9. Post the case on 25.06.2026. The direction to pay Rs. 15,000/- shall continue until modification. The personal appearance of the petitioners are dispensed with.
