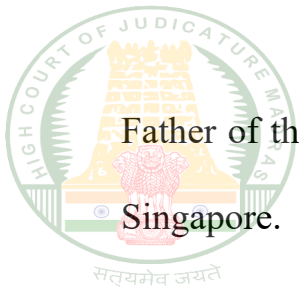

COMMON ORDER

When the matter is taken up today, the petitioner appeared in person and on behalf of the first respondent viz., K.S.S.Sivasubramanian, his father has appeared.

2. In respect of taking the minor daughter to Singapore, both the parties have agreed. Now the child is under the care and custody of the revision petitioner/mother.



Father of the child is entitled to be with the daughter from 01.05.2026 to 31.05.2026 at Singapore.

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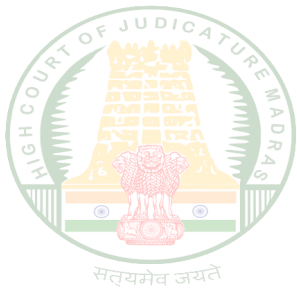
3. The revision petitioner/ H.Lalithambigai is directed to hand over the child to the first respondent/K.S.S.Sivasubramanian on 01.05.2026. It is also stated that passport is to be renewed for both the parties including the child and for that purpose, the child has to appear for enquiry before Passport Office at Coimbatore.

4. In view of the above, the Revision petitioner in CRP No.1767 of 2026 viz., H.Lalithambigai is directed to cooperate for renewing the passport.

5. It is directed that the Passport belongs to the revision petitioner/H.Lalithambigai is to be handed over to her since she has to travel to Australia to be with her brother along with her child after the child returns from Singapore.

6. The first respondent in CRP No.1767 of 2026 viz., K.S.S.Sivasubramanian is directed to hand over the child to the revision petitioner/H.Lalithambigai after returning from Singapore.

7. After returning from Australia, the passport belongs to the child should be handed over to the first respondent/ K.S.S.Sivasubramanian for renewal and after

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renewal, the original passports belong to H.Lalithambigai and the child are directed to be deposited before the trial Court and it shall be in the custody of the trial court till the completion of the proceedings. If they want Passport, they can file a proper application before the trial Court to get interim custody of the passport.

8. The revision petitioner/H.Lalithambigai is permitted to take the child along with her to Australia to be with her brother for a period of four weeks.

9. The E-copy of the passport belongs to the child is directed to be handed over to the revision petitioner/ H.Lalithambigai to enable her to apply Visa proceedings for travelling to Australia.

10. Both the parties are directed to comply with the order passed by this Court in respect of taking over and handing over of child.

11. The Joint Memo filed by the petitioner and the 1st respondent is recorded.

12. Post the matter “For Reporting Compliance” on 09.06.2026.
