Heard the learned counsel for the revision petitioners. Perused the records.

2. This Civil Revision petition is filed aggrieved by the orders dated 28.11.2022 passed in I.A.No.24 of 2021 in O.S.No.275 of 2012 on the file of the District Munsif Court, Panruti.

3. It is submitted that originally when the suit in O.S.No.275 of 2012 was filed, the respondents/defendants made an appearance, subsequently remained *exparte* and thereby, declaration of the suit was granted. Subsequently, the respondents/defendants kept quiet when the petitioners are brought the Revenue authorities. After *exparte* decree, the petitioners/plaintiffs have also issued a legal notice and demanded costs as the suit was decreed with costs. The respondents, fully aware of the decree passed in favour of the petitioners, after lapse of 7 years, have filed an application in I.A.No.24 of 2021 to condone the delay of 2170 days

and the same was allowed. It is submitted that the petitioners/defendants have filed a counter in the said application and demonstrated the respondents, who are having the knowledge of passing of exparte decree and participated in many official proceedings, but the Trial Court has ignored to consider the same.

4. Considering the circumstances explained, Admit. Issue notice to the respondents. Private notice is also permitted.
