(The rupee equivalent of US \$ 3,01,044.071 @ Rs.45.84)

realization are paid by the 1st Defendant to the Plaintiff.

c. Ordering costs of the suit in favour of the
Plaintiff.

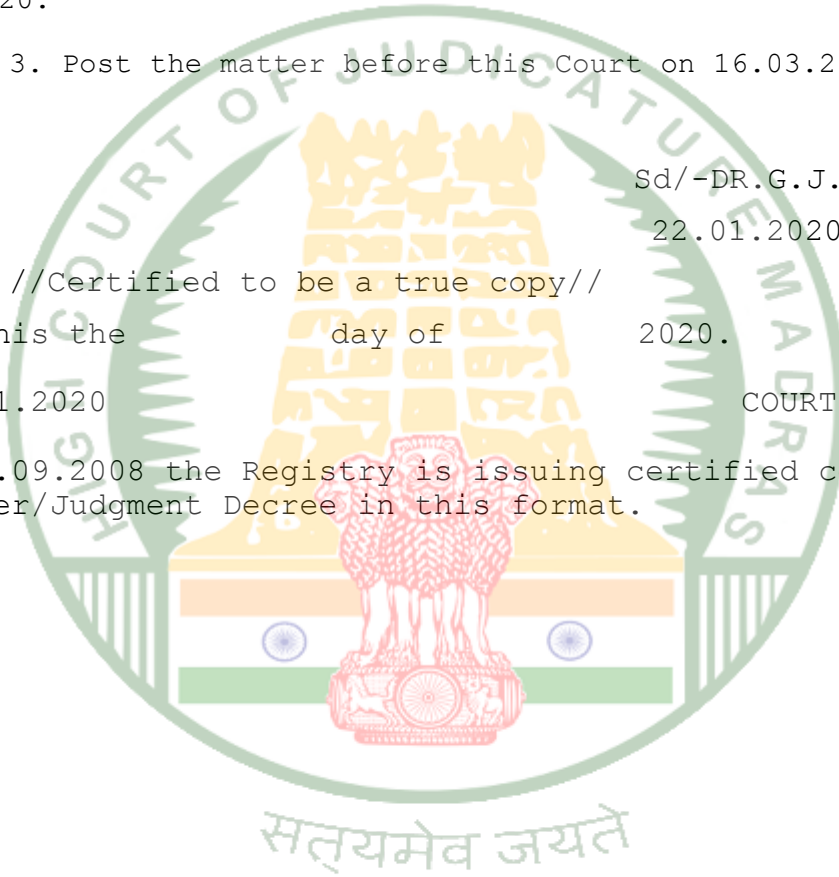
