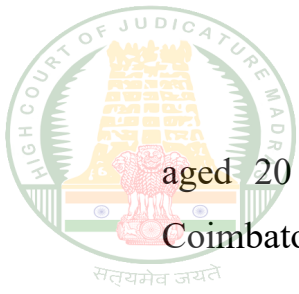

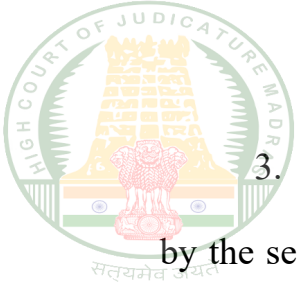

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by K. Rajasekar, J.)

Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), on instructions, submitted that the detainee has already been convicted in the ground case and undergoing life imprisonment.

2. The purpose of detention order is to prevent the detainee from indulging in similar offence and the ground case is the base for detaining the detainee. However, the detainee herein has been convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment in the ground case, hence the detention order passed against the detainee will not serve any purpose, at this stage.



3. In view of the above, the detention order dated 04.12.2025 passed by the second respondent in C.NO.204/G/IS/2025 dated 04.12.2025 against the detainee is hereby set aside. Accordingly, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands allowed.
