The following issues are framed for consideration in this civil suit:

(i) Whether the plaintiff's export company is eligible for interest concession as per the loan agreement and bank guidelines?

(ii) Whether it is correct on the part of the second defendant bank to charge penal interest of 18.50% per annum from the date of availing the credit?

(iii) Whether it is correct on the part of the 2nd defendant bank to deny interest concession to the plaintiff company for 16 months atleast upto June 2012?

(iv) Whether the plaintiff company is entitled to the refund of Rs.1,20,82,541/- (Rupees one crore twenty lakhs eighty two thousand five hundred forty one only) which has been excessively charged by the 2nd defendant bank?

(v) Whether the plaintiff company is entitled to 16.5% interest on the excess amount debited from the Packing Credit Limit by the bank to the tune of Rs.1,00,92,379/- (Rupees one crore ninety two thousand three hundred and seventy nine only)?

(vi) To what other reliefs, the plaintiff is entitled to?

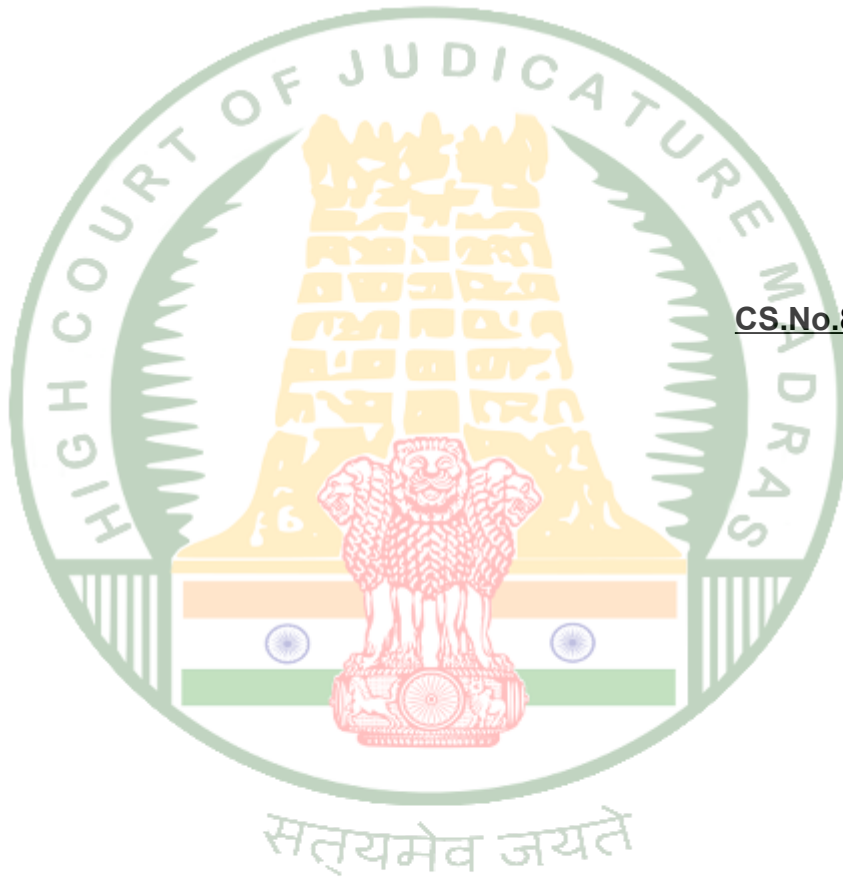
