COMMON ORDER

There are two applications filed before this Court. A.No. 5896 of 2025 is filed to condone the delay of 241 days in filing the inventory and A.No. 5897 of 2025 is filed to condone the delay of 57 days in filing the accounts in pursuance of the order dated 24.11.2022 passed in the above original petition. The reason stated for the delay is that the applicant is not aware of the legal procedure that after grant of probate in his favour by the Court, he has to file the inventory and accounts in respect of the property of the deceased within the stipulated time granted under the law and so he had not contacted his earlier Counsel. Though this Court is not completely satisfied with the reason for delay, in order to provide one fair opportunity to the applicant to enjoy the fruits of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, this Court is inclined to allow these applications on cost.



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In fine, these applications will be allowed on cost of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) to be paid by the applicant in the Hon'ble Chief Justice Relief Fund within four weeks.
