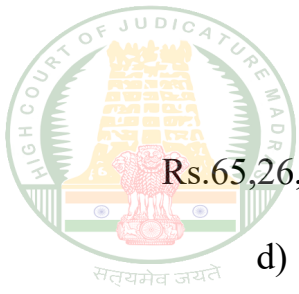

**PRAYER in COMP.A No. 52 of 2026**

- a) To take this report on record.
- b) To permit the Official to disburse dividend at 100 percentage on the admitted amount of Rs.65,26,628/- to 85 claimants as per the 5th supplementary list of creditors as mentioned in para 16 of this report in form no.71 is enclosed as Annexure A with this report.
- c) To permit the Official Liquidator to open a dividend account with Punjab National Bank, NSC Bose Road Branch, Chennai for a sum of



Rs.65,26,628/- for disbursement of dividend to 85 claimants.

d) To permit the Official Liquidator to keep the dividend account open for a period of six months from the dated of opening/ activating the account and to transfer the unpaid dividend, if any, to the Registrar of Companies, Tamilnadu, Chennai as per the provisions of Section 555(1) and (3) of the companies Act, 1956.

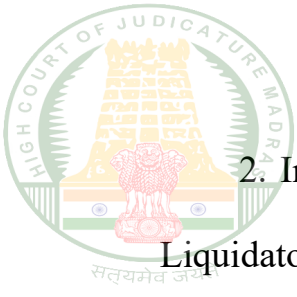
e) To dispense with the requirement of succession certificate and to disburse the dividend to the Legal heirs of the deceased claimants on submission of the Legal Heir Certificate, No Objection Certificate, Death Certificate etc.

f) To permit the Official Liquidator to defray the expenditure in connection with declaration of dividend including the cost of this application from the funds of the company in provisional liquidation.

### **ORDER**

The Official Liquidator has applied for permission to disburse dividend at 100% on the admitted amount of Rs.65,26,628/- to 85 claimants as per details set out in form 71, which is annexed to the application. Orders incidental or ancillary thereto are also requested for.



2. In the report in support of the application, it is stated that the Official Liquidator has adjudicated 85 claims in an aggregate sum of Rs.65,26,628/-. It is also stated in the report that there are sufficient funds to make disbursement in respect of admitted claims.
