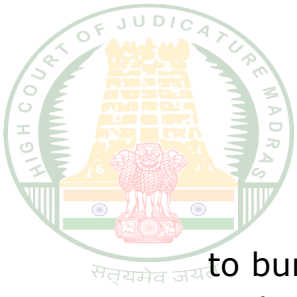

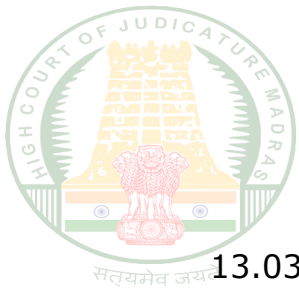

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents to measure the burial ground lands situate in Survey No.122 and pathway leading to burial ground situate in Survey No.124 in Ayyur Agaram Village map and other revenue records and demarcate the extents available in Survey No.122 and 124 and fence up the same and to lay proper blacktop road in Survey No.124 leading to the burial ground situate in Survey No.122.

2. Pursuant to the representation submitted by petitioner on

13.03.2026, the Revenue Inspector of Vikravandi, has submitted the report to the Tahsildar, Vikravandi. However, no final decision has been taken by the authorities.

3. Learned counsel for State submits that the authorities shall take appropriate decision in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

4. In view of the aforesaid submission, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent authorities to decide the representation of petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. We have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case. There shall be no order as to costs.
