Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the records.

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2. This Revision petition is filed aggrieved by the dismissal of I.A.No.1 of 2022 in O.S.No.29 of 2014 dated 08.12.2022 on the file of the learned Subordinate Judge, Tiruvallur.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that as defendants, they have moved an application in I.A.No.1 of 2022, seeking for sending the signature on the disputed document to an handwriting expert to compare the signature on the disputed document with the admitted document.

4. The learned Trial Judge has dismissed the application on the ground that the petitioners did not have any contemporaneous document to compare the signature of the deceased defendant to that of the disputed signature. It is submitted that as per the practice prevailing after sending the disputed signature to the handwriting expert, the contemporaneous document containing the signature of the defendant, will be submitted directly.
