ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to quash the order passed by the first respondent in RC.No.A-40/NGB.III(1)/06/2026 dated 09.02.2026, in sofaras the petitioner is concerned.



2. The case of the petitioner is that she is working as Grade-I Police Constable. Originally, she was transferred and posted at AWPS, Valparai on 24.08.2024 and subsequently, she was posted on deputation at Anamalai Police Station on 08.08.2025. Though there is no complaint, enquiry, charge or any adverse remark against the petitioner, the first respondent passed the impugned order transferring her to South Zone, Madurai. The petitioner has also made a mercy petition to the first respondent, however, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner's husband, who is also working in the Police Department as a Head Constable, has already been transferred to a faraway place. Now the petitioner has also been transferred to the South Zone, which is a far away from the place where she is presently working, namely, West Zone. He would further submit that the petitioner has three daughters and one son, who are all studying in schools and college in and around Coimbatore and she is also taking care of her aged mother-in-law and father-in-law.

4. Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials on record.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the first respondent is directed to sympathetically consider the mercy petition of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders for her transfer to any station within the same zone. Till such time the mercy petition is considered, the impugned transfer order shall not be given effect to.

6. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
