ORDER

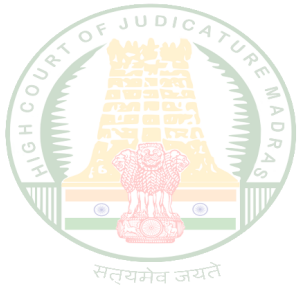
4. In view of the above, Registry is directed to number the Civil Revision Petition and list this matter on 03.11.2025.
