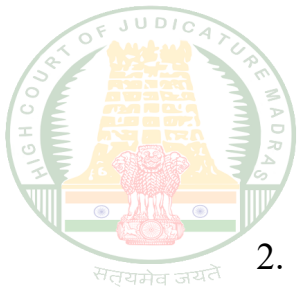

To direct the Judicial Magistrate I, Tambaram who has passed the order in Crl.M.P.No.7345 of 2022 in Domestic Violence No.24 of 2017, dated 10.1.2023 not to release the benefits till the petitioners arrears are paid pending disposal of the CRP.SR.No.57916 of 2025 and pass such other order or orders that deems fit and proper under the circumstances of the case and thus render justice.

Order

This Court passed an interim order on 11.11.2025 restraining the Judicial Magistrate I, Tambaram, from releasing a sum of Rs.8,02,000/- from and out of the retirement benefits payable to the respondent until further orders are passed in the above Civil Revision Petition.

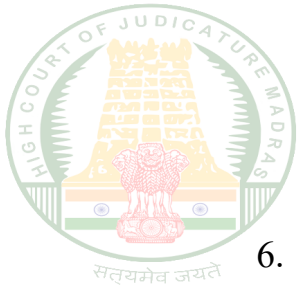


2. Thereafter, the order was periodically extended. Meanwhile, the respondent filed an application to amend the prayer in the Civil Revision Petition. The said amendment application was allowed by this Court on 12.01.2026 in CMP No.697 of 2026 in CRP No.5561 of 2025.

3. Though notice was duly served on the respondent and the respondent's name has been printed in the cause-list, there is no appearance either in person or through counsel on behalf of the respondent.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the amendment made to the prayer in the Civil Revision Petition, prayed that the interim injunction granted by this Court may be modified by incorporating the relief sought in the amended prayer.

5. In view of the above, the interim order granted by this Court on 11.11.2025 is modified to the effect that there shall be an order of interim injunction restraining the Judicial Magistrate I, Tambaram, from releasing the sum of Rs.8,02,000/- along with the accrued benefits to the Respondent until the petitioner's arrears are paid, petitioner's Stridhana Jewels are returned and a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- is paid towards the damages for medical expenses and mental agony, until further orders.



6. Post this case for hearing on 17.06.2026.
