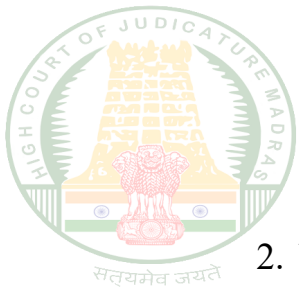

### **ORDER**

The present Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to forthwith return the Bank guarantee issued by the petitioner in favour of the respondent for the sum of Rs.53,51,276/- on 24.02.2020 bearing BG No.11650100017390.

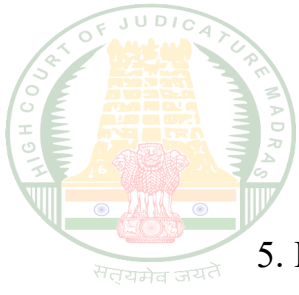


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2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner's Company had participated in the tender for supply, installation, commissioning and handing over of CCTV with IP cameras in 475 Police Stations in the Chennai City in the year 2020 and they had also successfully installed the CCTVs and completed their work. He further submitted that on completion of their work, since the respondents did not return the security deposit issued in the form of Bank guarantee by the petitioner in favour of the respondent for the sum of Rs.53,51,276/- on 24.02.2020 bearing BG No.11650100017390 and hence, the present Writ Petition.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that a *prima-facie* case has been made out by the petitioner for grant of an interim injunction not to invoke the security deposit issued in the form of bank guarantee by the petitioner to the respondent to the tune of Rs.53,51,276/-.

4. Notice to the respondent returnable by 17.06.2026. Private notice is also permitted.



5. Registry is directed to list the matter on 17.06.2026. In the meanwhile,  
the respondent shall file their counter affidavit.
