BUY BACK SCHEME

Today, a status report is filed by the TASMAC.

2. The status report filed by the TASMAC indicates that a total sum of Rs.11,20,00,000/- being the amount which was charged more than the MRP for empty bottle buy back scheme is maintained in a separate account. The status report further indicates that buy back scheme is proposed to be implemented in 12 Districts viz.,Cuddalore, Ariyalur, Pudukkottai, Sivagangai, Ramnad, Karur, Arakkonam, Viruthunagar, Erode, Tiruchi, Tanjavur and Vellore from 15th July, 2024 and in respect of all other remaining Districts, the scheme is proposed to be implemented from September, 2024.



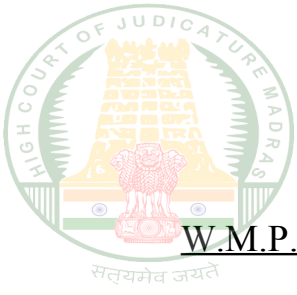
WEB COPY3. Mr.T.Mohan, learned senior counsel appearing as Amicus Curiae

would submit that after getting back the empty bottles under the buy back scheme, in order to ensure that all the empty liquor bottles should go only to the hands of the manufacturers concerned and should not go to any third party and also to reduce the work burden of the TASMAL staff and the difficulties in the storage of empty bottles at the respective TASMAL shops for want of sufficient storage space, the manufactures of liquor bottles should be directed to come and take back the empty bottles from the TASMAL shops regularly.

4. Mr.J.Ravindran, learned Additional Advocate General would submit that TASMAL would take appropriate steps in this regard in consultation with the stakeholders and inform the court on the next date of hearing.
