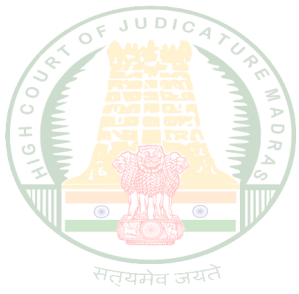

ORDER

In a proposed suit for damages and injunctive relief pertaining to alleged disparaging post by the defendants, the intending plaintiff seeks leave to sue. In

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the additional affidavit in support of the application, it is stated that queries were raised by the intending plaintiff's partners in Chennai referencing the post and that the intending plaintiff has over five lakhs followers in the Greater Chennai area.

2. Upon considering the draft plaint and the additional affidavit, it appears that a part of the cause of action has arisen in Chennai inasmuch as the intending plaintiff asserts that it has a large number of followers/users in Chennai. Therefore, this application is allowed by granting leave to the applicant to sue the respondents before this Court. As a corollary, the Registry is directed to number the suit, if otherwise in order.
