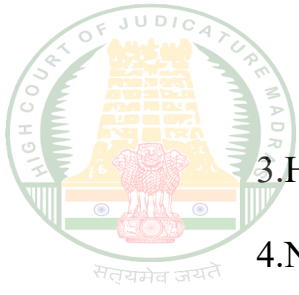

ORDER

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the issue involved in the Civil Revision Petition, among other issues, is whether the execution petition is barred by limitation. The learned counsel submitted that the Court below failed to note that the present execution petition was not a new petition, but a revival of the petition already filed and closed for statistical purposes. The learned counsel further submitted that if the properties are assigned to any politician or a sham body, the petitioner would be put to irreparable injury and loss. The learned counsel therefore prayed for appropriate orders.

2.This Court finds that there are arguable issues in the Civil Revision Petition and a *prima facie* case is made out for grant of interim orders and further, the balance of convenience is also in favour of the petitioner.



3.Hence, **there shall be an order of interim injunction till 03.06.2026.**

4.Notice to the respondent through Court as well as privately, returnable
by 03.06.2026.

5.Post the matter on **03.06.2026.**
