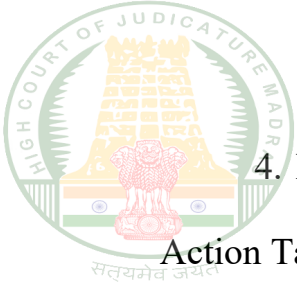
ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by Dr.G.Jayachandran J.)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the land in occupation of the fifth respondent belongs to Corporation.

2. However, the fifth respondent has filed typed sets of papers, containing TSLR Extract pertaining to R.S.No.2349/1, wherein the record shows that the occupancy and ownership of the property in S.No.2349/1 has been mutated in favour of the Trustees of Palaniandavar Amman Temple as per the Nodal Officer, PAG Chennai proceedings No.A2/3094/2021, dated 15.07.2022, TR dated 10.08.2022.

3. Learned Government Advocate is directed to produce the records pertaining to the proceedings mentioned above to ascertain whether mutation was done after the Corporation, in whose name the property stood, was given notice and heard.



4. Learned counsel appearing for the Corporation is also directed to file Action Taken Report on the alleged encroachment.

5. Since it is now contended by the counsel for the fifth respondent that the property belongs to Palaniandavar Amman Temple and it comes under the control of HR & CE Department, counsel for the petitioner is directed to implead HR & CE Department.

6. Post the matter after two weeks.
