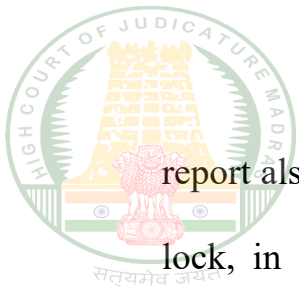

ORDER

The learned counsel for the revision petitioner submits that the revision petitioner, mother of the first respondent, is aged about 67 years. There is a dispute between them. As on date, the mother is residing at ground floor but her belongings and articles were kept in first floor, which is now under the lock and key of the respondents. She wants to take her belongings for day to day life. The counsel further submits that as on date both the respondents are at United Kingdom and passed all these years. The first floor of the house is under lock and key. In the presence of the Advocate Commissioner she is permitted to take her belongings with the help of jurisdictional police. At the time of taking the articles the first respondent is also permitted to see the process through Video Conference and both the counsels are also directed to appear on that day along with Advocate Commissioner.

2. Mr.M.Selvam (Enrol. No.138/99), is appointed as an Advocate Commissioner is assisted by the revision petitioner to take her belongings and



report also been submitted before this Court on 02.06.2026. If the room is under lock, in the presence of police, the Advocate Commissioner is permitted to break open the lock on 08.05.2026. The Advocate Commissioner fee is to be paid by the petitioner at Rs.25,000/-

3. The learned counsel for the 2nd respondent bank also appeared, but he is no way connected with the case.
