Both the appellant and the respondent have appeared before this Bench.

2. The respondent is not willing for settlement, as, he is willing to pay only a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- in full and final settlement to the appellant, to which, the appellant is not agreeable. It also appears that the respondent is not willing to pay any single pie than the said amount, despite, we pointed out about the plight and predicament of his minor girl child. A Suit for Partition is also pending, wherein, the respondent has 1/6th share of the property, which comes around Rs.41,03,334/-(as seen from the Memo filed by the appellant today). That apart, Mediation also not fructified.

3. Therefore, we direct the Registry to post the matter for arguments during second week of March, 2026, i.e. 09.03.2026, as there is no likelihood of any settlement between the parties.
