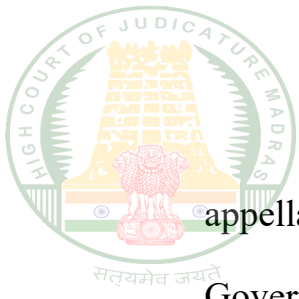

We have heard the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned counsel for the second respondent.

2. The appeal arises from a claim for injuries suffered in an accident by the appellant herein. The appellant had sought enhancement of compensation. However, the learned counsel for the respondent contended that to determine the functional disability or even the disability, the appellant had not been assessed by the Medical Board and only the opinion of a private hospital had been taken into consideration by the Tribunal while determining the permanent disability at 95%.

3. It would only be appropriate that an assessment from the Medical Board is received by us to determine the status of the appellant as on date.

4. We would therefore direct the appellant to appear before the Medical Board at Government General Hospital at Salem. We would request the Dean, Government General Hospital at Salem to form a medical team to evaluate and assess the injuries suffered by the appellant in the accident on 01.05.2017. The

appellant may appear before the Dean, Rangarajan Kumaramangalam Government General Hospital at Salem on 08.05.2026 and thereafter, the Dean, may form a medical team to assess the appellant herein. The appellant may also take all the relevant medical records with her.

5. List the matter on 10.06.2026, for report from the Medical Board at Salem.
