Based on the pleadings of the respective parties, the following issues are framed by this Court.

(i) Whether the declaratory relief of copyright owner over the schedule films obtained by the plaintiff on 07.03.2001 in C.S.No.385 of 1998 is binding on the defendants?

(ii) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for permanent injunction sought for against the defendants for infringing the plaintiff's copyrights over the entire musical works in the schedule mentioned feature films in any manner?

(iii) When the first defendant firm has assigned entire copyright over the musical work in favour of the plaintiff regarding the schedule films in the year 1997 itself for valuable consideration, the alleged claim of the third defendant relied on in his written statement is liable to be rejected?

(iv) Whether the plaintiff obtained rights for the musical works and connected sound recordings mentioned in the schedule to the plaint?

(v) Whether the plaintiff holds copyrights for the musical works of the third defendant?



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(vi) Whether the third defendant being author of
the musical works is the first owner of its copyrights?
