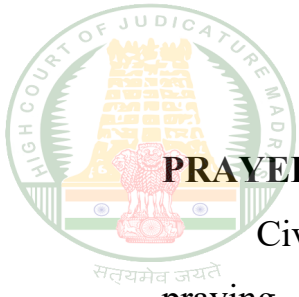

**PRAYER IN CRP No. 2489 of 2026**

Civil Revision Petition filed under Art.227 of Constitution of India, praying to set aside the impugned order dated 23.03.2026 passed in I.A.No.7/2025 in H.M.O.P.No.760/2024 on the file of the Family Court, Salem.

Civil Miscellaneous Petition filed under Sec.151 of C.P.C., praying to stay the operation and all further proceedings of the impugned order dated 23.03.2026 passed in I.A.No.7/2025 in H.M.O.P.No.760/2024 on the file of the Family Court, Salem pending disposal of the main CRP.

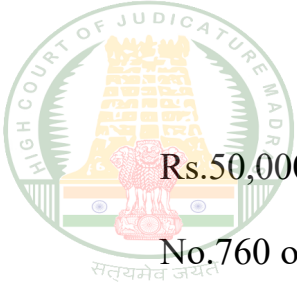

ORDER

Challenging the impugned order passed in I.A.No.7 of 2025 in HMOP No. 760 of 2024 by the learned Family Court, Salem directing the revision petitioner husband to pay monthly interim maintenance of Rs.90,000/-, revision petitioner/1st respondent had preferred this Civil Revision Petition.

2. The learned counsel for Revision Petitioner would submit that though the 1st respondent is employed in Bangalore and also having sufficient source of income, she had suppressed the said fact and the maintenance amount ordered by the Family Court is exorbitant one. He would submit that still he is having valid defence to prove his case. Hence, he prayed to modify the order passed by the Family Court.

3. Considering his submissions, the fact reveals that two children born to them and now they are under the custody of 1st respondent wife. Therefore, the revision petitioner, who is a father of children, he is directed to deposit a sum of



Rs.50,000/- until modification from the date of filing the petition in HMOP No.760 of 2024 to the credit of the said petition before the Family Court, Salem

with accrued interest and the arrears of maintenance is also ordered to be paid within a four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

4. Issue notice to the respondent returnable by 16.06.2026. Private notice is also permitted.

5. Post the matter on 16.06.2026. Until then, all further proceedings of the impugned order passed in I.A.No.7 of 2025 in HMOP No. 760 of 2024 on the file of Family Court, Salem is ordered to be stayed.
