**PRAYER**

Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of Constitution of India, praying to set aside the fair and decretal order in I.A.No.4 of 2024 dated 29.08.2025 in O.S.No.1438 of 2023 pending on the file of Learned III Additional Subordinate Judge, Coimbatore by allowing the present Civil Revision Petition and appoint an advocate as administrator to the Arulmigu Chitiraputhira Yemadharma Raja Temple till the disposal of the Suit.

ORDER

Challenging the impugned order passed in I.A.No.4 of 2024 dated 29.08.2025 in O.S.No.1438 of 2023 on the file of the III Additional Subordinate Judge, Coimbatore, the defendant 1, 2 & 4 have preferred the present civil revision petition.

2. Before the Trial Court, the petitioners filed an application seeking appointment of an Advocate as Administrator for Arulmighu Chithra Puthra Yemadharma Raja Temple. The Trial Court, however, declined to grant the said relief. The suit has been filed for permanent injunction, and the dispute pertains to the administration of the said temple along with the connected property.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Chitra Pournami festival falls on 01.05.2026 and that it is necessary to open the temple and conduct the festival on that day.



4. Considering the same, and in the interest of justice, this Court is inclined to grant an interim direction for the conduct of the Chitra Pournami festival, pending disposal of the CRP.

5. Accordingly, the Trial Judge is directed to appoint a local advocate, at the cost of the petitioner, having not less than 10 years of standing at the Bar on the civil side, as Administrator/ Advocate Commissioner to administer the affairs of the temple solely for the purpose of conducting the Chitra Pournami festival on 01.05.2026. The Advocate so appointed shall ensure that the festival is conducted peacefully and in an orderly manner, taking into consideration the welfare of the devotees. Both parties are directed to co-operate and shall not cause any annoyance during the opening of the temple and conduct of the festival.

6. The Trial Court shall submit a report before this Court on or before 10.06.2026. Issue notice to the respondents returnable by 10.06.2026. Post the matter on 10.06.2026.
