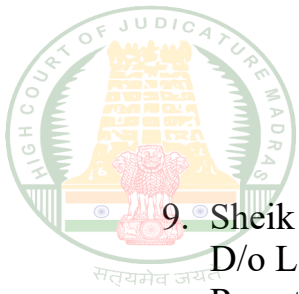

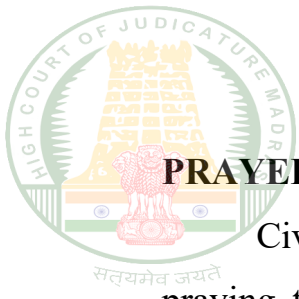

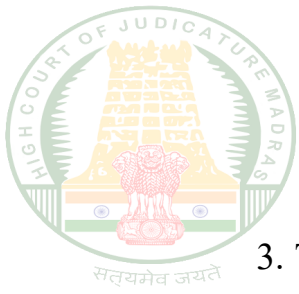

COMMON ORDER

Challenging the impugned common fair and decreetal order passed in I.A.Nos.14 and 13 of 2025 in O.S.No.69 of 2022 passed by the learned District Judge, Nagapattinam, the revision petitioner/1st defendant had preferred these Civil Revision Petitions.

2. Before the trial court, the respondents/plaintiffs 1 and 2 have filed the applications praying to implead Advocate General and the District Collector as defendants in the suit proceedings. But, inspite of objections raised on the side of defendants, the said application was allowed. Aggrieved over the said findings, these Civil Revision Petitions have been filed.



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3. The learned Government Advocate appearing for respondents 11 to 13 would submit that the proposed defendants are not necessary necessary parties to the proceedings. He would submit that in respect of the dispute with regard to a Charitable Trust, the proposed parties viz., Advocate General and the District Collector have no role nor there is any supervisory role in the day-to-day administration of the trust. So, impleading the proposed parties in the present suit is unnecessary one and there is a civil dispute between rival parties, who are the Trust, wherein the Government Authorities have no role. But, the trial court failed to consider the same and erroneously allowed the applications. Hence, he prayed to set aside the findings of trial judge.

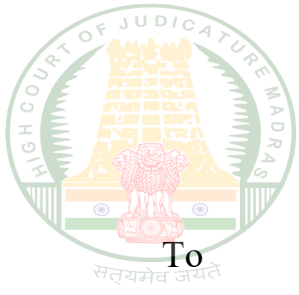
4. Records perused. Admit.
