Counsel for the 1st defendant.

Solemnly affirmed:

Q98: In the last occasion, you have stated that OS.No.4097/2013 was dismissed and an appeal was filed in A.S.No.79/2019. In the said appeal you have entered appearance, is it not?

A: Yes.

Q99: In the aforesaid suit OS.No.4097/2013, have you produced the Will subject matter of the TOS?

A: Yes.

Q100: I put it to you that you did not produce the Will and therefore, you have created the Will subsequent to the suit.

A: I deny.

Q101: Is it correct to state that at the time of registration of Ex.P1 Will your father was frequenting the hospital?

A: Yes, he was an out patient with diabetes.

Q102: I put it to you that nowhere in Ex.P1, Will has your father mentioned that it is his own property or the manner in which he acquired it.

A: I deny. Witness adds: It is mentioned that it is his self acquired property.

Q103: Is it correct to state that on the date of registration of the Will ie., 31.08.2005, the Tamilnadu Slum Clearance Board had not executed any sale deed in your father's favour.

A: Yes.

Q104: Is it correct to state that your father had executed two Wills prior to Ex.P1, Will?

A: I am not aware of them.

Q105: Is it correct that the aforesaid Wills have been registered on 31.01.1992 & 09.07.1995?

A: I am not aware of them.

Q106: (Ex.P1, Will is shown to the witness.) Is it correct to state that the signatures found in each page of Ex.P1, Will are different?

A: No. There is no difference.

Q107: I put it to you that the signature found in the 1st page of Ex.P1, Will is different from the signatures found in the 2nd and 3rd pages of Ex.P1.

A: I deny. Witness adds: All the signatures have been put by my father.

Q108: I put it to you that at the time of execution of Ex.P1, Will, your father was not in good health and sound state of mind and that you took advantage of the same.

A: I deny.

Q109: I put it to you that you took advantage of your occupation in Vijaya Hospital when your father was admitted there, with the intention to usurp the property for yourself.

A: I deny.

Q110: I put it to you that you have played fraud on your father and got Ex.P1, Will executed in a hurried manner and that is why his signatures are different in every page of Ex.P1, Will and that he did not intend to execute the Will in your favour.

A: I deny.

Q111: (Ex.P1 is shown to the witness.) Who are the attesting witnesses to Ex.P1 Will?

A: Abdul Nazar and Guna.

Q112: Who are they?

A: I do not know them. They were known to my father.

Q113: Had they come to the Sub Registrar's Office and did you enquire your father about them?

A: They came to the Sub Registrar's Office but I did not enquire about them from my father.

Q114: Did you enquire your father about them after execution of Ex.P1 till his death? If so, when?

A: I did not enquire about them from my father.

Q115: Have you seen advocate Veerappan?

A: Yes.

Q116: Have you been to his office?

A: Yes.

Q117: Who gave the documents and instructed the advocate in the preparation of the Will?

A: My father did.

Q118: Did the said advocate also come to the Sub Registrar's Office on the day of registration of Ex.P1?

A: Yes.

Q119: Who brought this Will to the SRO's office on the day of registration?

A: My father brought the Will.

Q120: Had your father already signed in Ex.P1 Will or did he sign at the SRO's office?

A: My father signed at the SRO's office in the presence of the officials.

Q121: Who is M. Rajan?

A: My father told me that he is also a witness.

Q122: Can you tell the court, what was the time on which the Ex.P1 was presented before SRO?

A: In the morning around 11.00 A.M.

Q123: At that point of time, whether witnesses have been assembled or they have come after your father and yourself arrived?

A: The witnesses were present even before we went to the Sub Registrar's Office.

Q124: You have told that your father signed before the authorities. Can you tell the court where the witnesses have signed?

A: They have also signed before the officers.

Q125: Can you tell the court, why the 2nd witness (Mr. Guna) in the Will, Ex.P1 did not identify in the registration process?

A: I am not aware of it.

Q126: Please see Ex.P1, Will. There is no Id proof for identifying witness Mr. Rajan, is it correct?

A: Yes.

Q127: I put it to you that Ex.P1, Will is a fabricated and it is not valid document and you are not entitled for Letters of Administration.

A: I deny.
