ORDER

This application filed seeking for an order of interim injunction restraining the respondent from representing the respondent herself to any bank, financial institution, insurer, TPA, vendor, patient, employee, governmental authority, or on any social media or digital platform as being authorised to bind,



manage, borrow on behalf of, or otherwise represent the Firm Medicare Eye Hospital, save and except in accordance with orders of this Court or the Arbitral Tribunal.

2. Heard Mr.R.Parthasarathy, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the applicant.

3. Considering the fact that the parties have exchanged notices under Section 21 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, wherein the respondent has also agreed for an arbitration, however, not on the nomination made by the applicant, but on the nomination suggested by her. It would indicate that there is a dispute between the parties in the Firm. Hence, there shall be an order of interim injunction restraining the respondent herself from independently acting as being authorised to represent the Firm 'Medicare Eye Hospital.

4. Issue notice to the respondent returnable in four weeks. Private notice is also permitted.
