Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 2 to 4 to issue computer patta and update all revenue records in name of the petitioner with regard to her property in S.No.615/34 to an extent of 3 cents, situated at Athimaranthur Village, Kendaiyanahalli Revenue Village, Pennagaram Taluk, Dharmapuri District.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents 2 to 4 to issue computer patta and update all Revenue records in name of the petitioner with regard to her property in S.No.615/34 to an extent of 3 cents, situated at Athimaranthur Village, Kendaiyanahalli Revenue Village, Pennagaram Taluk, Dharmapuri District.

2.The petitioner states that the petitioner is a resident of Athimaruthur Village and owns house site property in S.No.615/34 to an extent of 3 Cents situated at Kendiyanahalli Revenue Village, Pennagaram Taluk, Dharmapuri District. The petitioner is in possession and enjoyment of the said land for several decades. On 25.11.2011, the 2nd respondent has issued assignment patta in respect of the property in S.No.615/4 to an extent of 3 Cents in favour of the petitioner under the Tamil Nadu House Site Patta Scheme. However, it is the grievance of the petitioner that, so far, regular patta has not been updated online in respect of her property. Therefore, the petitioner made an application to the 3rd respondent on 04.03.2025 for issuance of computer patta to her in respect of



the subject property. Since no action was taken, the petitioner has come forward with this writ petition.

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3.Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that it would suffice if this Court directs the 3rd respondent to consider the petitioner's application dated 04.03.2025 and pass appropriate orders within a time frame.

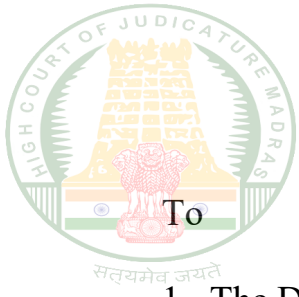
4.Mr.S.Arumugam, learned counsel who takes notice for the respondents, would submit that the petitioner's application will be considered by the 3rd respondent and appropriate orders will be passed within a period of six weeks.

5.In view of the limited nature of relief now sought for by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court directs the 3rd respondent to consider the petitioner's application dated 04.03.2025, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity to the petitioner, and pass appropriate orders within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
