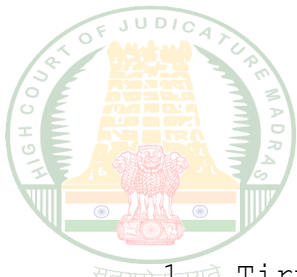

Second Appeal against the Judgment and Decree of the Learned Additional District Judge, Tiruvannamalai dated 29.07.2021 made in A.S.No.3 of 2017 thereby confirming the decree and Judgment of the Learned Principal Subordinate Judge, Tiruvannamalai dated 02.11.2015 made in O.S.No.38 of 2011 wherein the suit was dismissed, for the following among other (IN SA.No.829/2021) and;

(ii)To grant an order of Ad-Interim Injunction to restrain the Respondents herein from disturbing the Petitioner's possession of the schedule mentioned in O.S.No.38 of 2011, Principal Sub Court Tiruvannamalai, (IN CMP.No.15990/2021) pending disposal of the above SA.No.829/2021.

Learned counsel for the Appellants is directed to file Affidavit of Service. Post the matter on 10.01.2022. Interim order already granted by this Court is extended till then.

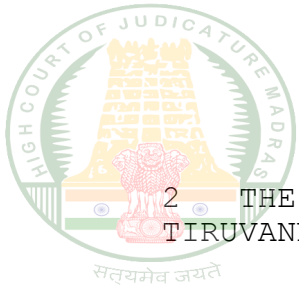
