After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent, it appears that the child requires further care and comfort of the mother at this stage of her life. She is just 2 ½ years old as on date. Let me not relate the background facts as any observation will only aggravate the issues between the petitioner and respondent, particularly taking into consideration the fact that the learned counsel for the petitioner had expressed that the petitioner would like reunion with the respondent.

2. At any rate, an interim arrangement is made that the petitioner may bring over the child to the Creche within the Family Court at Chennai on 03.05.2024, 17.05.2024 and 31.05.2024 at around 10.30 a.m. and the respondent can be with the child for about 3 hours on each one of those 3 days. The respondent may take care that if the child ever requires the immediate comfort of the mother, he should handover the child to the mother.



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3. The Member Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Legal Services Authority may depute a Para Legal Worker to also be present during such visitation time.

4. Let both the parties file an affidavit regarding their experience during such visitation.

5. List the matter once again on 10.06.2024.
