Judgment

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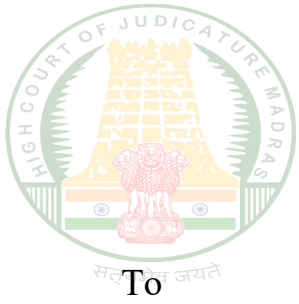
2. Mr.P.velmurugan, learned counsel for the 5th respondent on 15.07.2026, had reported that he will get instructions from the Commissioner of Coimbatore Corporation, as regards the provision for providing a burial ground for members of the Schedule Caste community to bury their dead.

3. Today, Mr.Aakash, counsel representing Mr.Velmurugan reports that the Commissioner has not troubled the Standing counsel with instructions. As a last chance, time is granted by two weeks. In case, the Commissioner does not give instructions for adequate provisions for providing a burial ground for Scheduled Caste persons, this Court will be constrained to impose costs. The Commissioner will be liable to pay costs personally.
