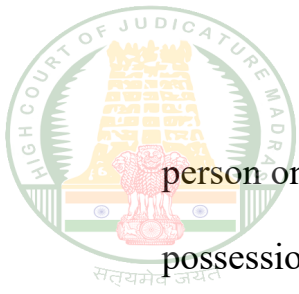

### **ORDER**

The present application has been filed to grant an order of interim injunction, restraining Respondents, their men, agents, servants or any other



person on behalf of the Respondents in any manner interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of carrying on the business of the applicant in premises Plot Nos54-63, in Swaminathan Nagar Layout, in No:22, Sedharpet Village, Villianur Commune and comprised in R.S.No19/8, Cadasthar No:15/229/201 (Part), Puduchery pending disposal of the arbitration proceedings.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant.

3. Under Asset Agreement dated 17.12.2025, an agreement had been entered into between the applicant and the respondent with regard to the schedule properties described therein, together with the machineries. By a communication dated 28.02.2026, the respondent had also acknowledged the transfer of the properties under the Asset Agreement and the applicant had been put in possession thereof. A communication had been addressed by the respondent to the applicant, indicating disputes between its Directors and had sought for extension of time for executing the registered instrument. However, by further communications, the applicant had been called upon to restrain his operations and hand over the amounts generated from such operations. A categorical apprehension has been pleaded that there has been serious attempts to dispossess the applicant, of which possession has been validly handed over.



4. In such view of the matter, there shall be an order of interim injunction  
as prayed for.
