**ORDER**

The learned counsel for the appellant submitted that whenever the Revising Committee refuses to certify a film, it must state its reasons and provide specific details regarding the objectionable portions, dialogues or scenes. Such disclosure is necessary to enable the appellant to either re-submit the film with modifications or prefer an appeal. In the present case, the Revising Committee failed to provide these specific particulars although, the Committee is mandated to supply these details in accordance with Form VIII to allow the appellant to make the requisite modifications.

2. Notice to the respondents, returnable by 24.06.2026. Private notice is also permitted.

3. The learned counsel for the appellant is also permitted to take notice on the office of the learned Additional Solicitor General.
