By order dated 21.12.2022, after considering the submissions of both sides, the applicants, who are the parents of the deceased father of the child, were permitted access to the child by visiting Cuddalore once a fortnight. They were permitted to pick up the child from the mother's house on Saturday morning at 10.00 A.M on condition that the child should be handed over to the mother on or before 5.00 P.M on Sunday. Learned counsel for the applicants states that the order was not complied with by the respondent on that date and that access to the child was denied.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent states that the child was not handed over to the applicants on account of apprehension that the applicants would take the child to Chennai. He also submits that the child is not comfortable with his paternal grandparents.

3. The order dated 21.12.2022 was passed after taking into consideration the submissions of learned counsel for the respondent. In spite of the same, the order has not been complied with by citing the apprehensions set out at paragraph 2 above. By balancing the legitimate desire of the paternal grandparents of the child to spend time with the

daughter of their deceased son and the apprehensions expressed on behalf of the mother of the child, the following directions are issued:

(i) The applicants shall be provided access to the child between 21.01.2023 and 22.01.2023. As specified in the earlier order, the child shall be picked up by the applicants from the mother's house on 21.01.2023 at about 10.00 A.M. and handed over to the mother of the child on or before 5.00 P.M. on 22.01.2023.

(ii) The child shall not be taken out of Cuddalore during the above period.

(iii) Both parties shall extend necessary co-operation to ensure that the above directions are complied with.

4. List the matter on 25.01.2023.
