(I) Issue orders, direction or writs in particular A Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records of the 2nd respondent in connection with the impugned order bearing Rc.No.9132/EDS2/2019 dated 24/04/2019 and the consequent impugned proceedings No.534/A5 /2019 dated 15/05/2019 and the consequent impugned proceedings No.534/A5/2019 dated 16/05/2019 issued by 3rd respondent and quash the same and direct the respondents herein to pay the petitioners pay in the 7th Pay commission recommendations corresponding to the Scale of Pay of Rs15600 - Rs.39100 with Grade pay in the 6th Pay Commission recommendations with effect from the same date as given to other Government Servants together with interest for the arrears amount payable to the petitioners in WP.NO.25659 OF 2019.

(II) Calling for the records of the respondent in connection with the impugned proceedings No.534/A5 /2019, dated 15/05/2019 and consequent proceedings No.534/A5 /2019 dated 16/05/2019 issued by the 3rd respondent and quash the same and direct the respondents herein to pay the petitioners pay in the 7th Pay Commission recommendations corresponding to the Scale of Pay of Rs.15600 - Rs.39100 with Grade pay in the 6th pay Commission recommendations with effect from the same date as given to other Government Servants together with interest for the arrears amount payable to the petitioner IN WP.NO.25668 OF 2019.

(III) To issue an order of ad interim stay for staying the operation of the impugned order bearing Rc.No.9132/EDS2/2019 dated 24/04/2019 and the consequent impugned proceedings No.534/A5 /2019 dated 15/05/2019 subsequent proceedings No.534/A5/2019 dated 16/05/2019 issued by 3rd respondent in WMP.NO.25150 OF 2019 AND;

(IV) To issue an order of ad interim stay for staying the operation of the impugned order bearing RC.No.9132/EDS2/2019 dated 24/04/2019 passed by 2nd respondent and the impugned proceedings bearing Ref. No.534/A5/2019, dated 15/05/2019 and consequent proceedings No.534/A5/2019 dated 16/05/2019 passed by the 3rd respondent issued to the petitioners, (IN WMP.NO.25154 OF 2019) pending disposal of the writ petition No.25668 of 2019 respectively.
