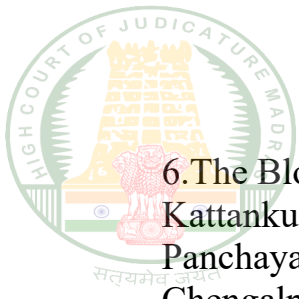

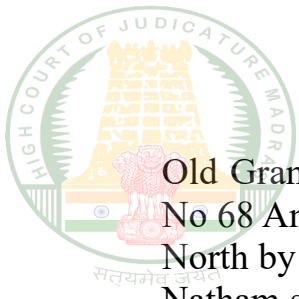

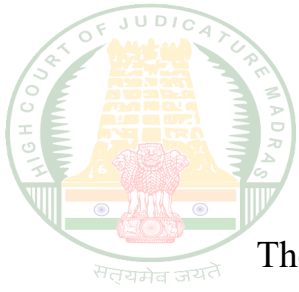

E (Vuu) dated Nil 10.2024 and its consequential work order, dated 14.10.2024 passed by the 7th respondent in respect of RCC storm Water Drain to Periya Eri surplus water in Anjur panchayat which was allotted to the 9th respondent, as to quash the same and consequentially direct the 9th respondent to close the diverted drain- channel and which was formed by the 9th respondent towards petitioners house property from its already existing actual course of drain channel and which is having 7 meter (24 feet) in breadth to its original condition before its development of the construction of RCC Strom Water Drain being carried out by him in front of petitioners house property to an extent of 78 feet in length and 13 feet in breadth and as not to carry out any construction of RCC storm water drain to peirya Eri surplus water in Anjur panchayat in and through petitioners house property and which is having a linear measurement as north to south on the eastern side 30 feet north to south on the western side 40 feet east to west on the northern side 136 feet (73 plus 15 plus 48 equal 136 feet) which is not a straight line but at the 73rd feet from west to east, the breadth north to south is extended toward north from 40 feet from west to east, the breadth north to south is extended towards north from 40 feet to 55 feet East to West on the southern side 118 feet comprised in

3. The registry to carry out amendment and list the Writ Petition on 03.12.2025.

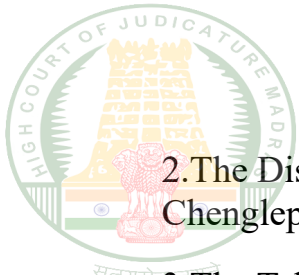
