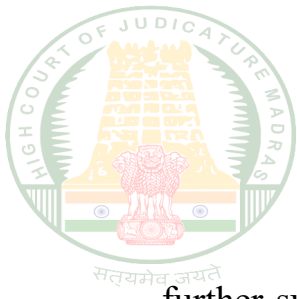

COMMON ORDER

Heard Mr.U.Baranidharan, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.P.B.Suresh Babu, learned counsel for the respondent in both CRPs.

2. According to the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petitioners have also filed writ petition and it is coming up for hearing on 20.07.2026, where the very same proceedings are being challenged. He would further state



that in the meantime, the execution petition has been ordered and attachment of the office of the petitioners has been ordered. He therefore seeks for some breathing time to bring up the writ petition and obtain suitable orders in the writ petition.

3. The learned counsel fro the respondent would fairly submit that he will not take further steps in the EP to effect attachment for a period of two weeks and to enable the petitioner to bring up the writ petition and obtain orders in his favour on 20.07.2026. The same is recorded and this will sufficiently protect the interest of the petitioners.

4. Post the matter on 24.07.2026.

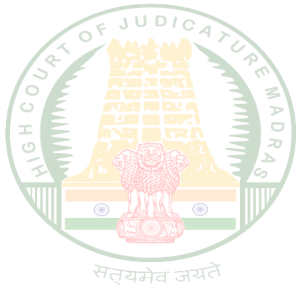
