The main contention raised on the side of the appellant is that the Tribunal has fixed a sum of Rs.6,63,141/- for the damage to the vehicle only based on the evidence that was given by PW3 through whom Ex.P7 was marked. The learned counsel submitted that the actual expenses that was incurred towards repairs was not placed before the tribunal.

3. The learned Additional Government Pleader is directed to produce records to show the actual expenses that were incurred by the 1st respondent to repair the vehicle. Based on the same, final orders will be passed in this appeal.
