to file an affidavit.

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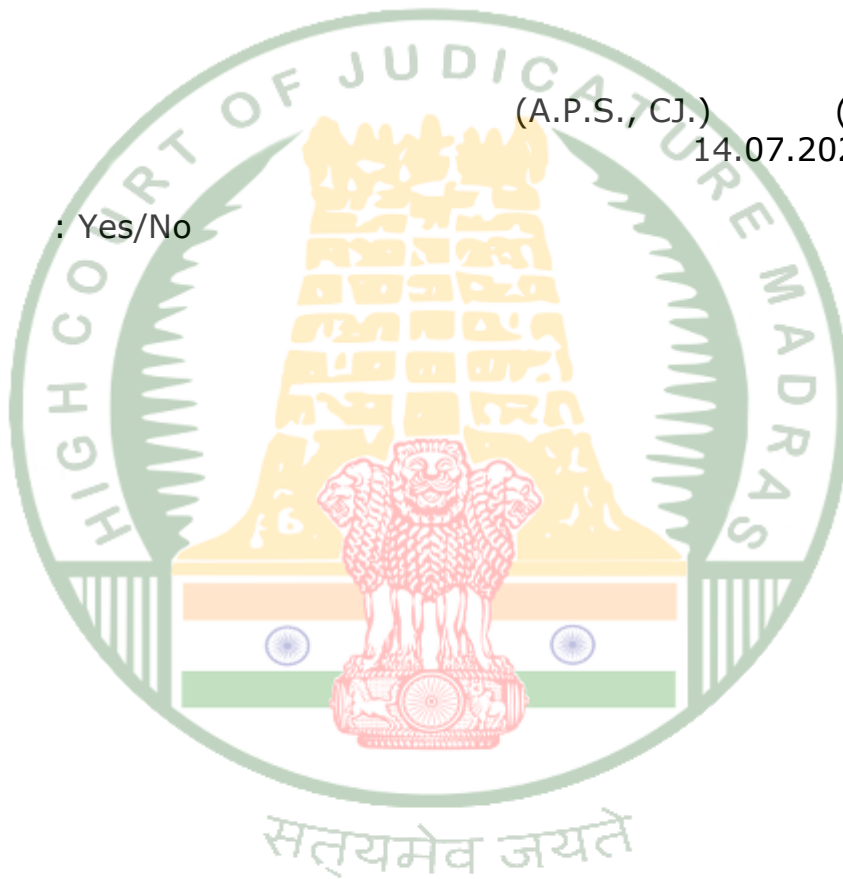
2.Ms.Deepika, learned counsel holding brief for Mr.C.Kasirajan,
