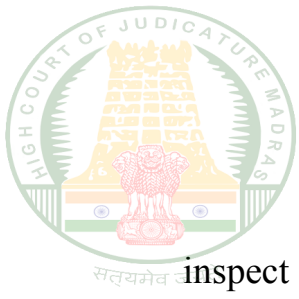

SEEKING STAY AGAINST THE NGT ORDER

Regarding W.M.P.No.8638 of 2023, Mr.SP. Chockalingam, learned counsel counsel for the Petitioner submits that the independent of this interim application a separate Writ Petition in W.P.No.8999 of 2023 challenging the very same order of the National Green Tribunal (NGT) by duly making all be Brick Klin owners as parties has been moved and it came up for hearing and the learned Judges have posted the Writ Petition before this Bench. In such a view of the matter it would be appropriate to take up the said writ petition along with the W.M.P.No.8638 of 2023. Post the said writ petition in W.P.No.8999 of 2023 on 17.04.2023.

2. In respect of this issue, we are of the view that personal inspection by the Bench is required in this matter. Accordingly, we have decided to



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inspect Thadagam and other areas connected with this writ petitions and the date of inspection will be intimated later to both sides.

SAFE GUARDING OF TWO CALVES

Regarding the earlier order passed by the First Bench of this Court of which one of us was the member on 07.03.2023 regarding safe guarding of the two calves which were alive after the electrocution of three elephants, Mr.S. Muralidharan, Party-in-person appearing would submit that in the process of celebrating the Oscar Awards, the those two calves were lost track of.

2. Refuting the said allegation, the learned Additional Advocate would submit that those two calves are very much traceable in the Thenkanikottai reserve forest area and that he will produce the affidavit as well as the photographs in support thereof by 27.03.2023. He would also submit that those two calves have joined the tusker and are safe as on date. He is also ready to file an affidavit and photograph by Monday i.e., on 27.03.2023. Let the said affidavit and photographs be filed on 27.03.2023.

5. Call this matter on 17.04.2023.

6. Depending on the filing of the Affidavit and the contents thereof it is put on notice that the hearing in the said matter may also be advanced, if



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necessary.

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DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY

Apart from the contempt petition (Cont.P.(MD) No.560/2023) which is filed regarding the conduct of joint patrolling and setting right of the low lying electricity lines, the learned Amicus have filed a detailed Memo highlighting the mandatory requirement of installing Earth Leakage Protective Device / Residual Current Device (ELPD / RCD). A copy of the said Memo has been duly served on the learned Standing Counsel for the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board.

2. The learned Additional Advocate General takes notice and submits that the same will be taken note of and put to the authorities and they will come up with their response to the said Memo. The response of this Memo shall also be called on 17.04.2023.
